- 4) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- 5) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the <u>TEAGUE POLICE DEPARTMENT</u>
 who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the <u>TEAGUE POLICE DEPARTMENT</u>
- 6) requires collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
 - a. the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
 - b. whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search;
 - whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual;
 - d. whether the peace officer used physical force that resulted in bodily injury during the stop;

- e. the location of the stop;
- f. the reason for the stop.
- 7) requires the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision (6) to:
 - a. the Commission on Law Enforcement; and
 - b. the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.


SUBJECT: Monthly Council Report **TO:** Mayor, City Council Members

Water: The wells pumped a combined total of 10,275,000 gallons of water in February with a daily average of 331,451 gallons. Multiple leaks have been repaired since our last meeting. I have completed the annual water use survey and will be working on completing the water loss audit this month along with our consumer confidence report.

Wastewater: The two aerators at the North WWTP have had their new soft starters installed and are running great. However, the third aerator is now having problems and we are working with a contractor on getting that resolved. The ATS for the generator at the North plant is also needing some repairs and we are currently waiting for estimates on that.

Facilities/Parks: We have been put on the schedule for Cen-Tex to install the fire alarm system. The new siren system is up and running and we are still working on getting everybody access to the system. The system is automatic and will sound when we receive a tornado warning or a severe weather event i.e. winds over 60mph and or large damaging hail. We will return to testing the first Wednesday of every month weather permitting.
